




## Summit Lake residents are twice as likely to live in poverty and their incomes have been trending downward






## Overall, Summit Lake residents have been closing the educational and employment gap with the city, but racial disparities exist











Parcels By Ownership 793 Total Parcels



















## North Route 1.85 miles



Begin at Roush's Market (554 Thornton)

Directions: West to La Croix; South to Parkdale; Manning Pond to Russell; East to Schumacher; North to Scheck; East to Norka; North to Thornton; West to Towpath Trail; South to Community Center.

## **Central Route** 1.66 miles



### Begin at Aldi (772 Main)

Directions: Begin Aldi's; East to Main; South to Roundabout; South on Old Main to Miller; West to Victory; North to Long; West to Lakeshore; North to Reach Center Driveway.

## **South Route** 1.65 miles



### Begin and end at Community Center.
